

Vacancy for positions in the pathology department of the Cliniques Universitaires Saint Luc in Brussels (starting September 2021).

General presentation.

This university hospital department located in Brussels consists of 12 permanent senior pathologists and 8 residents in training. The department activity is organised in subspecialties; each pathologist is in charge of a specific subspecialty and also participates in the activity of one other subspecialty to ensure continuity. The pathologist will participate in multidisciplinary team meetings and will work closely with other clinical colleagues involved in the required areas. The opportunity to participate in the teaching of medical students can be offered.

The department has a large immunohistochemistry portfolio with more than 200 antibodies and provides FISH/SISH analysis. We collaborate closely with the molecular biology platform for molecular tumour analysis (NGS, RNASeq, ...). The activities of the department are accredited according to the ISO-15189 standard.

1. Vacancy for a neuropathologist:

This junior pathologist will have the opportunity to be trained in this subspecialty by an emeritus colleague with an extensive expertise in neuropathology. The emeritus colleague will supervise her/him in daily routine clinical practice and is available for support in case the junior pathologist aims to perform research in the field of neuropathology. She/he will supervise cerebral autopsies.

Additional involvement in another pathology subspecialty is required. This additional subspecialty can be discussed with the present team members according to the present needs of the department.

2. Vacancy for a hepatopathologist:

This is a position for a junior pathologist wishing to become expert in hepato-pathology or for an experienced senior hepato-pathologist. Expertise in gastrointestinal pathology is an advantage.

The pathologist will be responsible for hepato-bilio-pancreatic pathology and will work closely together with the clinical team. The pathologist will also be responsible for diagnostic liver transplant pathology. She/he will have the opportunity to be involved in ongoing research projects in the field of hepato-bilio-pancreatic pathology and, in case of a junior pathologist; there is the possibility to start a research project in this field (PhD).

3. Vacancy for a pathologist (junior/ senior) with a special interest in dermatopathology:

Experience in dermatopathology is a pro, but is not a prerequisite. This pathologist will work closely with other colleagues involved in dermatopathology and with the dermatology department. Having a doctoral thesis is an advantage, but not mandatory.

4. Vacancy for an allround pathologist willing to participate to the global activity of the laboratory, and to collaborate with the other members of the team in the major domains (gastrointestinal pathology, senopathology, uropathology, gynecopathology).
